

DRESS CODE "FAST FACTS" 2009-2010

Shirts:

- Must have sleeves- no tank tops.
- Must be tucked in, if the shirt has tails.
- Must be sized to fit in traditional, modest manner.
- Must not include offensive designs or overt, covert, or implied messages relating to sexual innuendo, alcohol, drugs, tobacco products, or weapons.
- Must not be sheer, unless undershirt meets dress code guidelines.
- Must not show a bare midriff or have a "scoop" neckline.
- Must not extend below the fingertip of the hand.
- No bra straps or cleavage may be showing.

Pants Must:

- Fit at the top of the hipbone, be hemmed, and be short enough not to touch the ground.

Shorts Must:

- Measure longer than the tip of the middle finger and have inseams longer than four inches.
- Fall above the bottom of the knee.

Pants and Shorts Must NOT:

- Be baggy, oversized or skin tight or contain writing on the seat of the pants or shorts.
- Have holes, rips, cuts, tears, frays, or fringe.
- Sit low enough for undergarments to show above the top of pant or shorts.

Skirts:

- Length must measure longer than the tip of the middle finger when arms are fully extended at side.
- The top of a slit in a slit skirt must be below the middle finger.
- No undergarments or skin may show above the top of the skirt.
- No fringe or writing on the seat of the skirt.

Shoes Must NOT Be:

- Those that split the toe.
- Shower shoes, plastic or rubber slides, or bedroom slippers.
- Untied or unsecured; Velcro straps and laces must be fastened.
- Worn with the tongue of the shoe outside or on top of the pant bottom.

Jewelry:

- No piercing any body part except ears unless approved by Principal.
- Necklaces cannot be wider than a standard-size paperclip.
- Necklace pendants cannot be larger than a two-inch post-it note.
- Boys may only wear one stud earring. The earring may be no larger than a standard No. 2 pencil eraser.
- Female earrings may be no larger than a two inch post-it note (including hoops).
- Boys may not have painted fingernails.
- If jewelry presents a safety hazard, it must be removed.

Hair:

- No colored hair spray or glitter; normal hair color only.
- Must be top-of-the shoulder length or shorter (Boys).
- No designs may be shaved into hair or eyebrows.
- No facial hair of any kind.

Sweaters/Coats:

- Must NOT be oversized hooded sweatshirts and must fit appropriately.
- No sweater or coat may conceal a dress code violation. (Each piece of clothing must stand on its own to be in dress code).

Hats/Caps: are not permitted anywhere on campus except H/F or Athletics.

NO visible tattoos permitted. Students will be asked to conceal any visible tattoo.
