# Use camera features on your Chromebook

You can use the camera on your Chromebook to take photos or videos, or edit and print photos.

## Take a photo or video with your Chromebook

- 1. In the corner of your screen, select the Launcher  $\bigcirc$ .
- 2. Open Camera . Then, on the right side, choose an option:

Select Photo Take photo .

Select Video Start recording .

Select Square Take photo .

## Change how photos or videos are captured

Change your settings: Select Settings . Change the size of the grid, the length of the timer, or the camera resolution.

Flip your photo from left to right: Select Mirror 🕼 .

Use gridlines to straighten photos: Select Grid III.

Switch between cameras: At the left, select Switch camera . Tip: You can only switch cameras if you plug in an external camera or your Chromebook has 2 built-in cameras.

Take photos with a timer: Select Timer 🧖 .

Take photos with the volume buttons: When your Chromebook is in tablet mode, you can press the up or down volume button to take a photo. Learn more about tablet mode.

#### Find or delete your photos or videos

Find your photos and videos: In the bottom right corner of the Camera , select the thumbnail of your most recent photo or video. To see the photo or video larger, select it.

Important: To automatically store your photos and videos in Files , your Chromebook must run Chrome OS version 69 and up.

Delete your photo or video: Select Delete 🔳 .

Save photo or video: Photos and videos taken with the Camera of can be found in the "Downloads" folder of your Files.

### Edit your photos

To Edit, crop, or rotate your photo: Select Edit 🧪 .
